Quilted in Clay Announces New Line of Tools and Resources for Polymer Clay Artists

Alvarado, Minnesota — October 31, 2005 — Quilted in Clay announced today the availability of three new tools and resources for use by polymer clay artists. They include the Quilted in Clay Disc Set, the Quilted in Clay Acrylic Rods, and an autographed copy of the paperback book, *Polymer Clay Inspirations*. “I’ve been crafting with polymer clay for more than a decade,” said Jennifer Patterson, Artist and Owner of Quilted in Clay, “and I now want to offer valuable tools and information to others who are also interested in working with this wonderful medium.”

The line of artists’ tools and resources to date includes:

- The Quilted in Clay Disc Set comprised of 16 quilting templates designed to fit together to create a multitude of quilt designs. They make the process of extruding clay in different shapes much easier, and are sized to fit the standard Kemper Klay or Sculpey Clay Gun. The complete set sells for \$18.00.
- The Quilted in Clay Acrylic Rods are used to reduce square canes or blocks of clay into consistent sizes. Acrylic rods are best as clay does not build up easily on the surface and are easy to clean. This 10-rod set sells for \$59.00 and includes 2 rods in each of these 5 sizes – one inch, three-quarter inch, half-inch, three-eighth inch, and quarter-inch. All rods are 12 inches in length.
- *Polymer Clay Inspirations* is the print resource for exploring the artistic possibilities of polymer clay. The paperback is autographed by author Patricia Kimle and contributing author Jennifer Patterson, and sells for \$22.99 including shipping & handling.
